The perfect location

Aarhus is a dynamic city on the Jutland peninsula. From here, beach, harbour and forest are all only a 15-minute bike ride away. Denmark's youngest city!

13% of Aarhus' population are students, making Aarhus the youngest city in Denmark. Historically though, it's one of the oldest. 315,000 people live in Aarhus and 1.2 million people live in the greater Aarhus area, so it's the perfect size for a weekend break or family getaway.

Culture in Aarhus

Being young at heart means that the city can offer you a wide spectrum of cultural experiences, from [nightlife](#) [4], cultural events and [shopping](#) [5] to the best restaurants in the region. Aarhus is also home to popular festivals, such as Food Festival, [SPOT Festival](#) [6] and [NorthSide Music Festival](#) [7].

Diverse museums

Visit the distinctive art museum, [ARoS](#) [8], to see groundbreaking works from some of the world's most progressive artists. At [Moesgård Museum](#) [9], you can witness artefacts from the earliest period of the Viking Age. [Den Gamle By - The Old Town Museum](#) [10] is a unique, international attraction which you can walk around with your whole family.
